The Installation and removal of capillary injection systems. Job duties include but not limited to assisting the operator with loading and unloading of capillary units, preparing units and getting them ready for travel. Ability to travel and navigate to various well locations. Punctuality is a must. Job on site and in the shop include:

- Assisting the operator with spooling capillary tubing onto trailer, removing bands or clamps with rig crew.
- Assisting the operator with banding or clamping and operating the unit making sure the integrity of the capillary tubing remains intact and installation process is up to the customers standards and Flowco's standards.

- Assist in shop spooling capillary string and inspecting tubing.
